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HOW TO CREATE Your own game

TO START ASK YOURSELF:

- What types of games do you play? Sample answers: video games, board games, cards games
- What are the components of the games you play?

Sample answers: dice, tokens, cards, mouse, controller, board, timer, pen

- What are the names of the games you play? Sample answers: Snap, Snakes & Ladders, Chess, Video games, etc.
- What are the themes of the games you play? Sample answers: war, money, history, sports
- What makes a good/bad game? Sample answers: competitive, educational, easy to win, rules are too complicated etc.
